On September 12, 2013, the Massachusetts Port Authority (the "Authority") will hold a public hearing to be chaired by its CEO/Executive Director or his designee. The hearing will be held as follows:

The hearing will convene at 2:30 P.M. and will adjourn as and when deemed appropriate by the Chair.

At the public hearing, the Authority will receive comments from the public on proposed revisions to the regulations described below:

**740 CMR 21.00: BOSTON-LOGAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT,
LAURENCE G. HANSCOM FIELD, AND WORCESTER REGIONAL
AIRPORT – GENERAL PROVISIONS**

and

**740 CMR 22.00: BOSTON-LOGAN INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT,
LAURENCE G. HANSCOM FIELD, AND WORCESTER REGIONAL
AIRPORT – AERODROME OPERATIONS**

The purpose of the proposed revisions to 740 CMR 21.00 and 740 CMR 22.00 is to make certain operational and aerodrome safety and management regulations already in place at other Authority-owned airports (including Boston Logan International Airport and L.G. Hanscom Field), appropriately applicable to Worcester Regional Airport. The proposed amendment to the Authority's regulations would also eliminate certain existing regulatory provisions the Authority has deemed unnecessary or inapplicable to Worcester Regional Airport.


The public is invited to present oral or written comments at the hearing with respect to the proposed regulations. Written submissions should be presented at the hearing or filed with Ira M. Wallach, Associate Chief Legal Counsel of the Massachusetts Port Authority, One Harborside Drive, Suite 200S, East Boston, MA 02128.

Submissions that are mailed must be received by 5:00 p.m., Thursday, September 12, 2013, to be included in the record of public comment. Written submissions must be filed or presented in not less than 6 copies, shall state that they are intended for inclusion in the record of these hearings, must be signed by the individual writing the statement or by an individual authorized to act on behalf of any organization or group, and shall include the complete address and telephone number of the individual submitting them. The Authority's Legal Department will maintain a register of written submissions timely filed at the address above, and all such submissions will be available for public inspection.

Persons desiring to make statements and presentations at the hearing are invited to advise the Authority in advance to assist in scheduling of the conduct of the hearing, but are not required to do so.
