

- The USMX ILA master contract expires at midnight on September 30th, 2024.
- Conley Terminal will receive dry <u>export</u> cargo and empties through Monday, September 30<sup>th</sup> if no agreement is reached.
- Conley Terminal will receive refrigerated and hazardous <u>export</u> cargo through end of business on Wednesday, September 25<sup>th</sup> if no agreement is reached \*
- It is highly encouraged that all <u>import</u> cargo be picked up as soon as possible. If no agreement is reached, any <u>import</u> cargo that remains at Conley Terminal by close of business on September 30<sup>th</sup> will be unavailable until the stoppage ends.
- Should there be a work stoppage, <u>any</u> refrigerated cargo that remains in the terminal (<u>import and export</u>) will not be monitored nor maintained while the work stoppage is in effect.

<u>Note</u>: electricity charges for the refrigerated containers will remain in effect for all days that cargo remains onsite.

- Demurrage and storage charges will not be charged should there be a work stoppage.
- Dwell time of cargo and equipment will be paused should there be a work stoppage.
- The last vessel operation will end by 20:00 on Monday, September 30<sup>th</sup> if no agreement is reached
- Please see below **extended gate hours** for days prior to the possible work stoppage

Tuesday (9/24) - normal hours 08:00-17:00 (last truck in at 16:15)
Wednesday (9/25) – EARLY OPEN 07:00-17:00 (last truck in at 16:15)

Friday (9/27) – EARLY OPEN 07:00-17:00 (last truck in at 16:15)
Saturday & Sunday – closed
Monday (9/30) – EARLY OPEN 07:00-17:00 (last truck in at 16:15)

• Should there be a stoppage, Conley Terminal will be considering extending the gate hours once an agreement is reached to facilitate removing imports from the terminal and alleviating a possible surge of cargo should there be a pause in Operations.
